

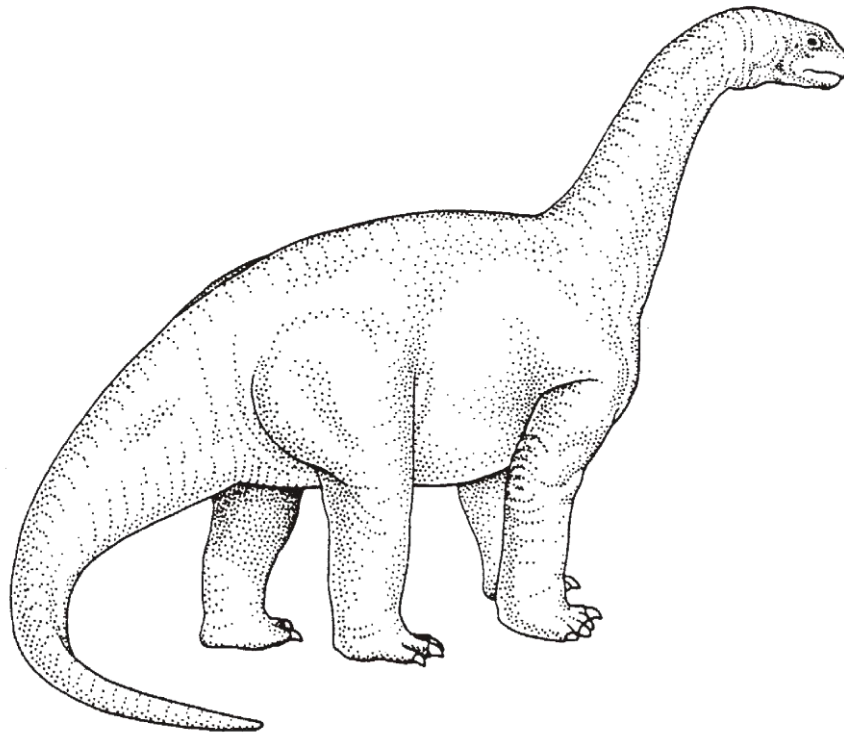
Make your own dinosaur model

Equipment:

'dinosaur bones' picture from the other side of this page with the individual pieces cut out
large cardboard boxes or sheets of stiff cardboard
wallpaper or paper mache glue
scissors
glue
masking tape

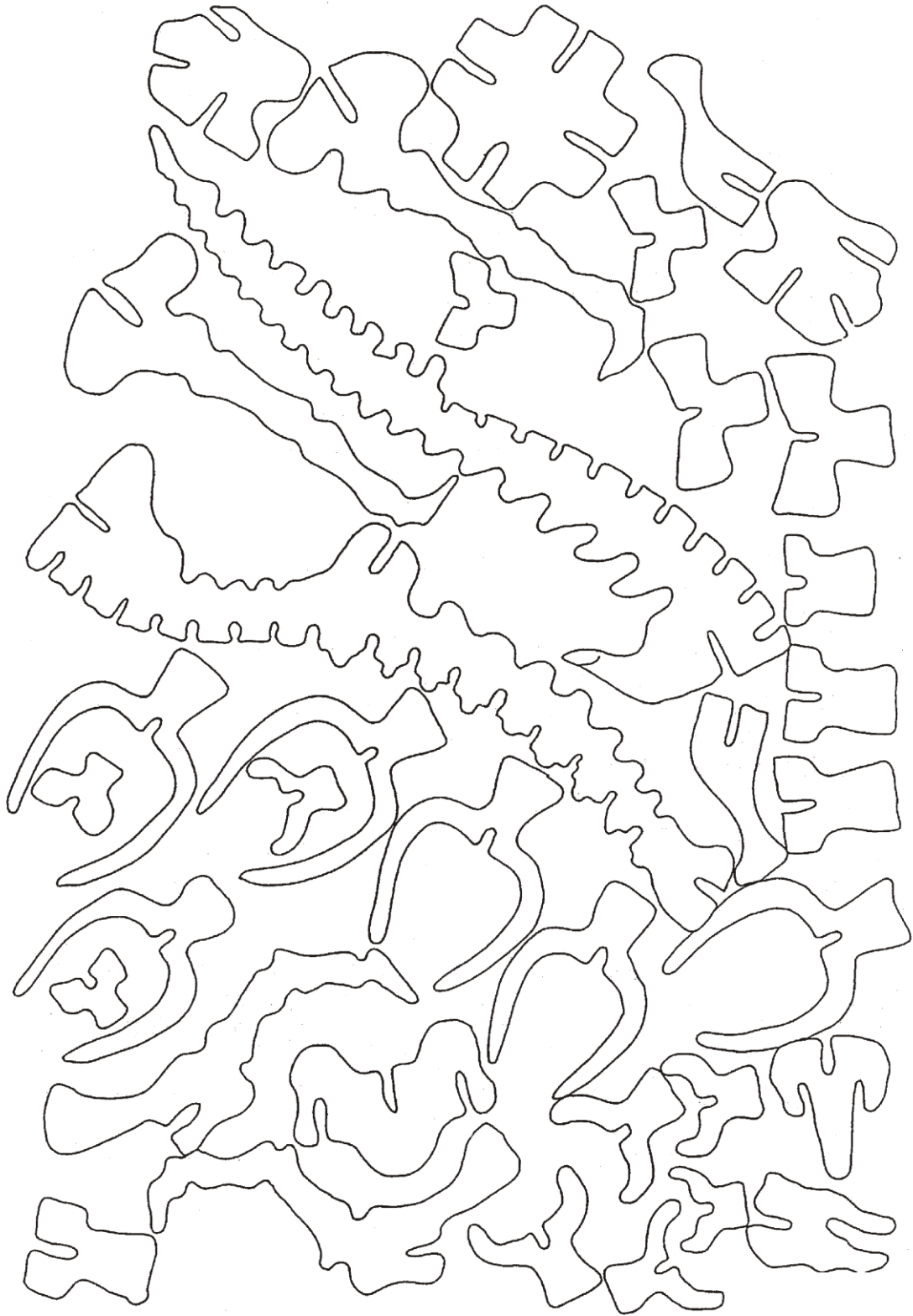
Procedure:

1. Trace around the cut out paper bones on to the cardboard.
2. Cut all the bone shapes out of cardboard. Assemble the cardboard cut out bones to make a standing 3D model of a dinosaur.
3. Crush small balls of newspaper to pad your dinosaur's body out a bit. Rip out strips of newspaper and using wallpaper paste, or similar, glue these strips of newspaper over the dinosaur model.
4. Once the paper is dry, you can finish the dinosaur off by pasting on coloured buttons for eyes and teeth, cut from plastic ice cream containers. Paint your dinosaur or make an outer skin for it. Create a textured effect by rubbing crayons on paper placed on concrete or a brick wall to create a textured effect.
